What if you could put a price tag on the line between a stable, safe living environment and homelessness? How much is that line worth?

Earlier this year, local nonprofit ShelterCare came up with one answer: \$356. In that scenario, \$356 kept a single mom with three children housed after they had received an eviction notice for late rent.

With that one-time stipend, the trajectory of four lives changed instantly.

Simple, effective, and sometimes outside-the-box approaches to homelessness have been hallmarks of the Eugene-based agency since 1970. ShelterCare has developed a toolbox of housing and recovery programs to counter the devastating affects of poverty, which now affects more than 17 percent of Oregonians. The organization serves three vulnerable populations: homeless adults with psychiatric disabilities; adults living with acquired brain injuries; and families with children who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Last year, ShelterCare helped 1,700 individuals in Eugene and Springfield.

Families with children comprise one of the fastest-growing segments of the homeless population. To help curb this trend, the agency aims to raise \$75,000 for 250 area homeless families during its “I ShelterCare about Homelessness” campaign running through October 31.

Last year, the inaugural month-long event generated more than \$50,000, which helped 238 Lane County families keep a roof over their heads. That’s 238 families afforded a chance to prepare Sunday meals together, or to enjoy a good nights sleep before first days of school.

Sometimes, funds paid late rental payments, enabling families to stay in their homes. Other monies paid deposits on new apartments for families transitioning back into stable housing, or helped keep emergency shelter units open for families with nowhere else to go.

Simple solutions, big results.

ShelterCare is one of many local organizations that offer unique solutions to this multi-layered problem. Despite this coordinated effort, homelessness remains. According to the 2013 Lane County One Night Homeless Count, 1,470 homeless households were counted, and 108 were families with children.

This October, the agency urges you to “ShelterCare about Homelessness,” and to bolster and secure that line between homelessness, and home.
