Soccer has taken Eugene by storm, and not just on the professional or club circuit. Boys' and girls' prep soccer have a niche as well, and for good reason: It's a rivalry. The matches between South Eugene and Sheldon's boys and girls teams have been dubbed the **Emerald Derby**. The two boys' teams, SEHS varsity head coach Jürgen Ruckaberle says, have been adversaries since they shared the 2002 state championship. SEHS enters 8-1 on the season, while Sheldon is 6-1-2. "Yes, this is a big rivalry, but at the end of the day, it is celebration of the Eugene-Springfield soccer community as a whole," says Sheldon boys' coach Zach Lazar. Both teams are currently ranked among the state's 10 best, with SEHS at second. On the girls' side, SEHS will look to get off the snide, having lost eight of their first 11 games while failing to score in six contests. Prevailing will be no easy task, as Sheldon is 6-1-1 thus far and ranked sixth in the state.
