REGGAE BREWHAHA

For a town who voted Sol Seed EW's Next Big Thing 2013, and whose big summer concerts included Slightly Stoopid, Rebelution and Matisyahu, the **Passafire-Ballyhoo!** double bill Feb. 6 at Cozmic is bound to be a big show.

Passafire leads the charge, riding the buzz wave of *Vines*, the band's 2013 album that opened at the number one spot on the Billboard Reggae Chart. *Vines* settles nicely in the rock-reggae pocket with fat, punchy beats, guitar riffs and lyrics that channel an earnest progressive populism only reggae can pull off without a high cheese factor, e.g., "I don't want to work for the sake of bringing home a check [bringing home a check]" on the track "All in Our Minds" or "When evil comes knocking at my door I do the right thing [right thing]" on "Right Thing." Lead singer Tom Brown anchors these songs with a voice reminiscent of Dispatch's Chad Urmston.

Joining Passafire for the bands' joint Winter Brewhaha 2014 tour, the pop-punk reggae Ballyhoo! will round out the night. Shades of Sublime, 311 and Incubus can be heard on the band's 2013 release, *Pineapple Grenade*, albeit with angstier vocals.

Bask in the backbeat of Brewhaha.

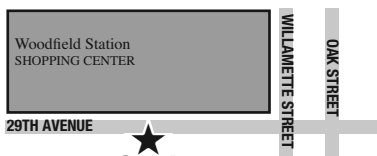
