

Ladybugs Praying Mantis Beneficial Nematodes

Nature's way to control pests in your garden*



Ladybugs – Feeding mainly on soft-bodied, plant-eating pests, these voracious predators are capable of eating 1000 or more aphids a day! An excellent alternative to sprays – especially in the vegetable or edible garden. *Approximately 1500 Ladybugs per pack.*

Praying Mantis – These powerful predatory carnivores feed on virtually any insect they catch. Early foods include aphids, and later cutworms, flies, moths, mosquitoes and more. *Each egg case hatches 100-200 baby mantis.*



Beneficial Nematodes – Nematodes are microscopic worm-like organisms parasitic to insect pests developing in the soil. These tiny powerhouses are very effective against cucumber beetle larva and root weevils – but are best known for flea control. *Covers 2500 sq. ft.*

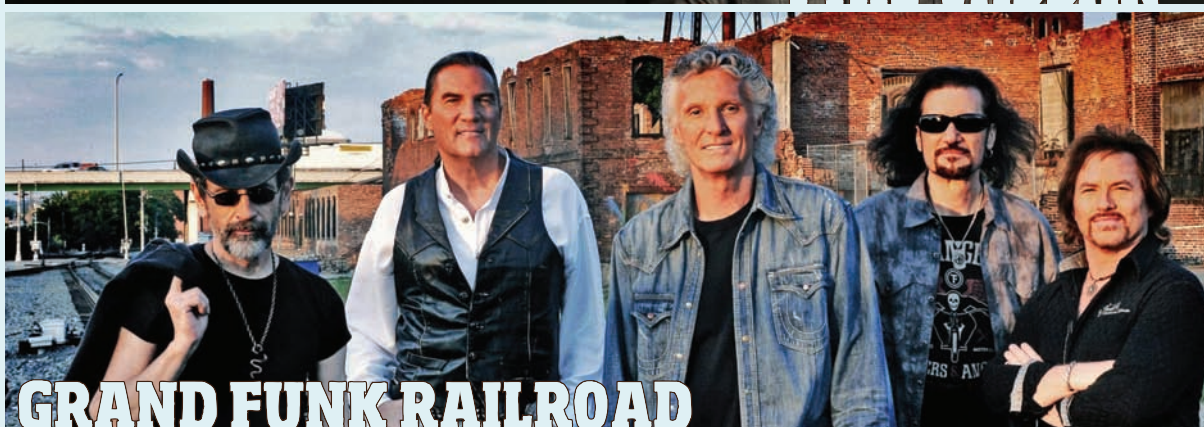
