Last week there were three fossil fuel explosions in the U.S. and one in Canada. What is your "threshold" for allowing corporate private profits to damage your

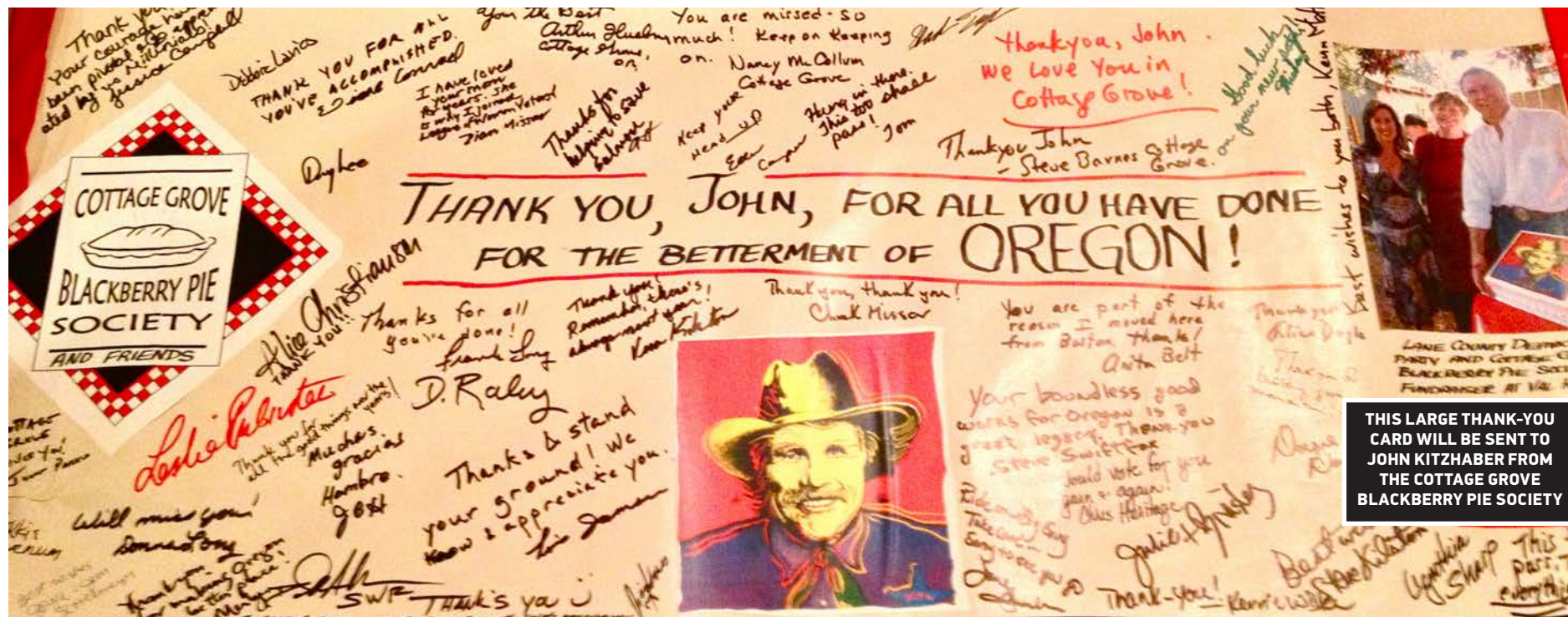
