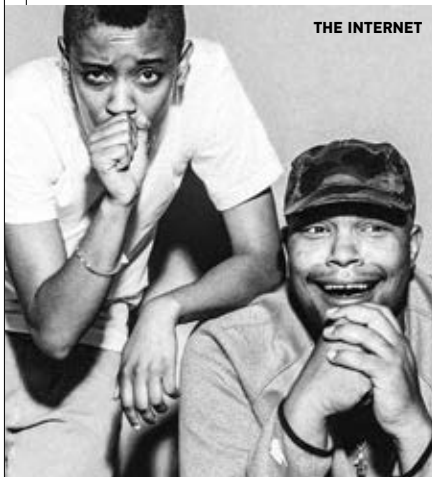

## GET READY FOR AN UPDATED SCHEDULE

- **What's changing?** Beginning on October 24th, the earliest weekend northbound train out of Eugene will depart at 9:00 a.m., arriving in Portland at 11:35 a.m., and continuing on to arrive in Seattle at 3:50 p.m.
- On weekends/holidays, a new Thruway bus will depart at 5:30 a.m. to connect with the northbound train departing Portland at 8:20 a.m.
- **Why is this important?** The updated schedule will make service more convenient and build ridership. Increasing ridership is critical to ensure continued state funding beyond the next two years.
