Costs \$3,500 tuition/homestay/excursion/hotels. Airfare and some meals not included.

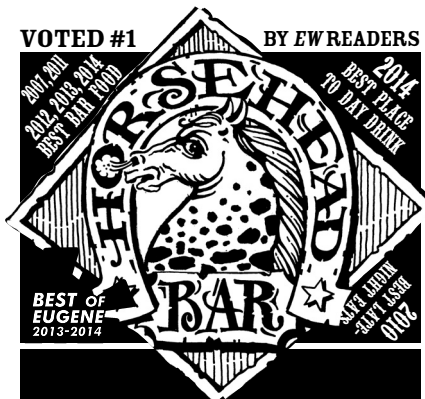
