Diehard KISS Army recruits can even be buried in official KISS coffins. Whatever it is you want, you can find it with a flaming KISS logo emblazoned on it. The lucrative theatrical hard rock glam band brings its Freedom to Rock Tour to Eugene Saturday, check out the merch tables.
