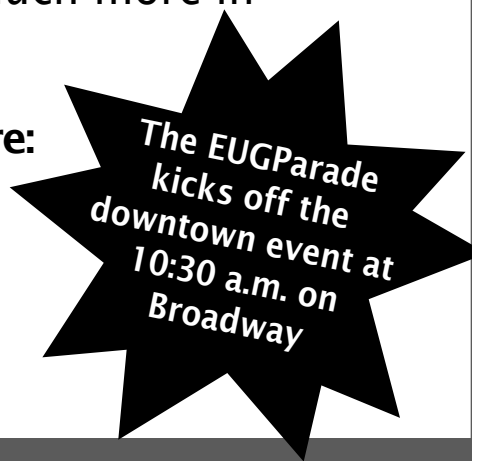


# EUGENE SUNDAY streets
