The **Fourth of July** is one of the best parts of summer, and here are some area events to check out before and during the big nighttime sha-bang. For a chance to take in some culture, visit **Art and the Vineyard**, Maude Kerns' three-day art and wine festival, July 2 to 4, in Alton Baker Park; it'll have a fireworks show on the Fourth. Want to spend your July 4 getting fit and breaking records? Register for the annual **Butte to Butte** to participate in a 10K, 5K or 4-mile walk. If you're looking for a buckin' good time, head to the 26th annual **Eugene Pro Rodeo** (90751 Prairie Road) on the Fourth. The rodeo runs July 1 to 4. It boasts the "largest fireworks in Lane County." Tickets range from \$12.75 to \$23.75. For more info, visit eugeneprorodeo.com. For some more traditional July 4 events, visit Springfield's Island Park (200 W. B Street) for the annual **Light of Liberty Celebration**. It offers live music, activities for kids and a fireworks show over the Willamette River. It's from 4 to 11 pm. Tickets are \$5 in advance and \$8 at the gate, and kids 5 and under are free. For another classic, catch the **Eugene Emeralds**, Eugene's minor league baseball team, playing Boise at PK Park for Red, White and Boom! Tickets aren't on sale yet, but run \$9-\$15.
