"People can come with their blankets and lawn chairs and kick it in the grass," Sheppard says. Alton Baker Park is a great venue, he says, because of the ample shade, space and parking. "We expect a good 1,500 people throughout the weekend," he adds. The event is family-friendly till dusk, with face painting tents available to keep your kids adorably occupied. Beats, Brews and BBQ is Friday, June 9, from 5-11 pm and Saturday, June 10, from noon-11 pm at Alton Baker Park. Tickets are \$15 for Friday, \$17 for Saturday, or \$25 for both.
