The Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art (1430 Johnson Lane) is wrapping up its multi-day Día de los Muertos celebration from 6-9 pm Thursday, Nov. 2. The event will feature traditional art, music, food, dance and poetry as well as altars with offerings. The event is FREE. For more Día de los Muertos fun, head to Maude Kerns Art Center (1910 E. 15th Avenue) to check out their Day of the Dead exhibit featuring photographer Salina Canizales and acrylic painter Eileen Finn (whose painting is the image for this blurb).
