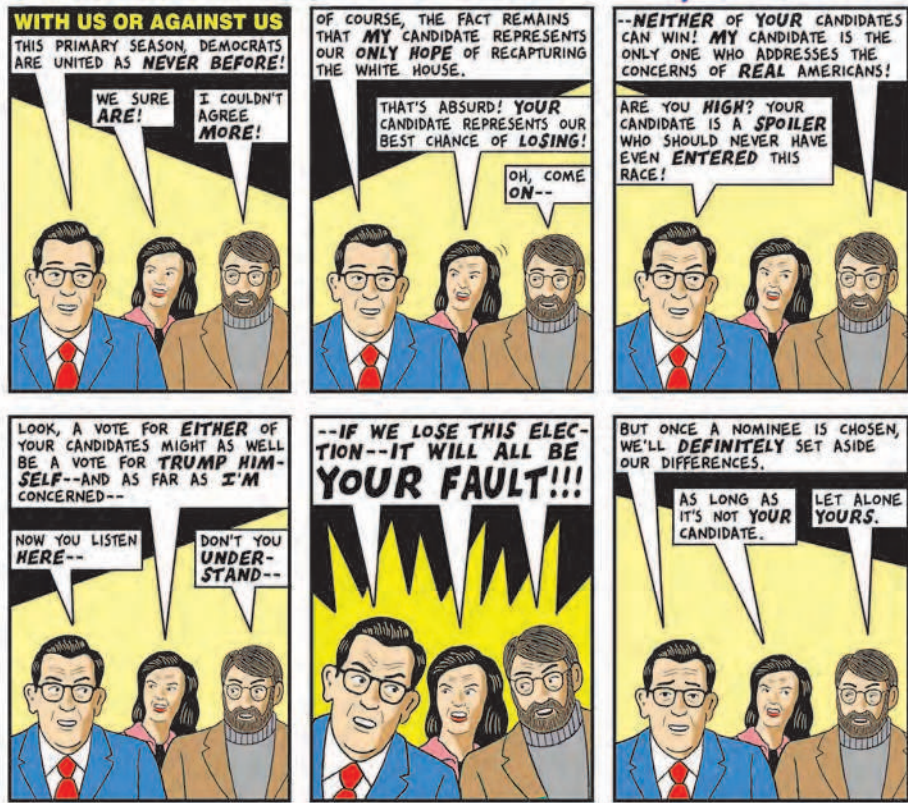

Was that the sound of Tom McCall rolling over in his grave?

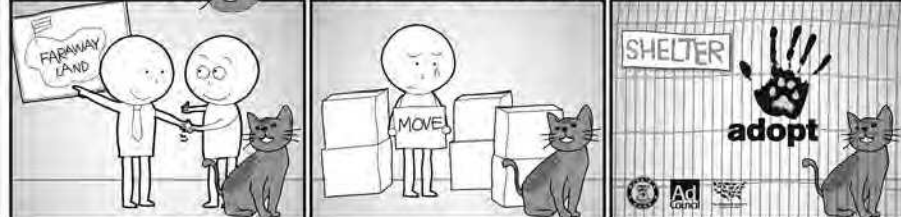

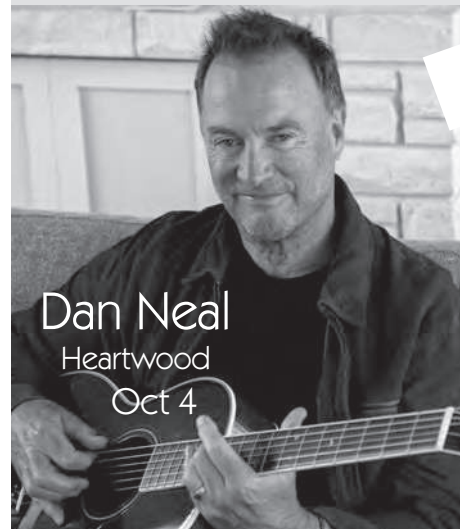
