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Sacred Heart Home Health and Hospice Nurses Need Your Support

Over the past six months, home health and hospice nurses working for PeaceHealth Sacred Heart have spent more than 250 hours at the bargaining table with PeaceHealth executives. We need a fair contract with PeaceHealth so you can keep receiving care from local nurses who provide high-quality, at-home care. But PeaceHealth is only willing to pay us about half of what they pay our fellow nurses at Sacred Heart Medical Center.

This is not right. PeaceHealth will cause good home care nurses to leave for other jobs, resulting in lower-quality care for you and your loved ones when you need nursing services at home.

In addition, **during the pandemic PeaceHealth CEO Liz Dunne received a raise of more than \$2 million, increasing her salary to \$6.2 million!** It's insulting that she'll take multimillion dollar raises but won't provide a fair wage increase to the nurses caring for patients.
