Quite a large delegation of Brookings-Harbor residents were present at the regular monthly meeting of the Curry County Court, held yesterday at Gold Beach.

The general need of improvement of the roads in this part of the county was presented to the court for its consideration by Leo Lucas, spokesman for the Brookings-Harbor delegation in this matter. The court assured the delegation that new equipment has been ordered, and promised that when the equipment is delivered to the county, the roads in this area will be improved.

Representation was also made to the court as objecting to inclusion of central areas in the proposed Brookings-Harbor rural fire district. No action was taken by the county court on either subject of interest to the Brookings-Harbor delegation.

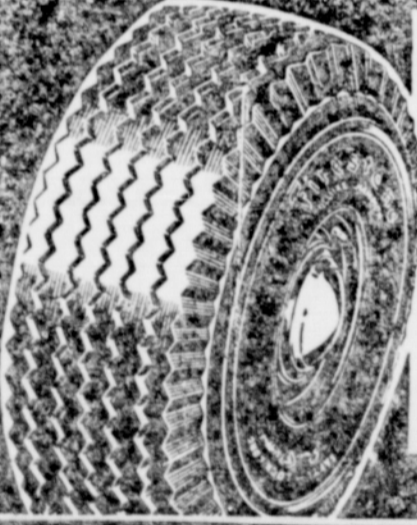
