

### Feed Situation Is Eased In Oregon

Feed shortages in Oregon were made less acute by the shipment of 36 more carloads of feed to midwest grain producers' co-operatives, according to the state office of production and marketing administration of the USDA.

The five cars of gluten meal and 31 cars of oats and barley will be sold to local feed mixers selected by the administration feed advisory committee.

All of this shipment will be in Oregon soon, it was pointed out. Of the nine carloads of feed coming last week, five went to Washington and four to Oregon.

### Coos Co. Man Shot By Son, Wednesday

Word came to Brookings, Wednesday morning of fatal shooting of Dolph Coleman, 53 at his home on Big Creek, near the Bridge community, in Coos county. The 15-year-old son of the slain told this story:

"Coleman was choking his wife and ignored please to stop. The boy picked up a 22 calibre rifle and fired twice. Coleman died almost immediately.

Following his testimony at the coroner's inquest the lad was not held.

### Meat Shortage Hits Bay Area Hard

Brookings and Harbor are no worse off than San Francisco in the meat situation anyway. According to the San Francisco Examiner: "San Francisco housewives yesterday resumed an almost futile search for meat after a two-day 'holiday.'"

A check of the Bay area markets found beef supplies literally out with many markets closing their doors because they had nothing to offer. A scant supply of lamb was sprinkled throughout the city, and there was a good supply of fish and poultry. But beef, veal, bacon and pork were missing.
