Lakeview: Rocky Mountain spotted fever was fatal Monday to George A. Stephenson, 70, a Lakeview lumberman.

He came to Oregon 40 years ago after engaging in the lumber business briefly in his native state of Maine and in Michigan, Wisconsin and Minnesota.

Survivors include a widow and one son.

Sheridan: Phil Sheridan Days, a picturesque celebration of the days when Phil Sheridan, famed Civil War General, rode this area, will be observed here this weekend. Rodeos and everything that goes with such western days, will be enjoyed.

Gold Hill: A small gravel plant is in operation near here and is producing concrete sand and gravel.

Gold Hill: A suction-type gold dredge started operations here below the bridge and is working down Rogue River.
