Power Plant Hit When Engine Breaks, Wed.

Avoid Excessive
Use At Hours of
Peak Loads, Plea

Users of electricity in this area are requested, for a time, to use the very minimum of current possible, until repairs can be made on the main diesel engine at the Coos Electric Coop plant.

Early Wednesday morning, residents of the area noticed their lights suddenly grow dim. This was brought about when the large diesel, the old standby, from overwork, and lack of time to make necessary repairs, went bad.

The two portable units, already taxed to capacity, now must carry the entire load. With care on part of the local users, no serious consequences will result, providing care is continued on use of electricity at times when usual peak loads are used, that is— at noon hour, in the evening, and again in the early morning hours.

Reason for this condition locally is explained by the fact that the electric load in the area has increased by more than three times since the first of this year. The two portable generators, added early in March, have never been able of late to carry the peak load easily, even with aid of the main diesel, which has long needed a general overhauling.

Electricity

Dear Coop Members In This Area:

Wednesday morning early, our large diesel, the old standby, failed us, and thus an enormous load is being thrown on the two portable units, which, primarily were intended for auxiliary aid to the present equipment.

Since January of this year, the electric consumption of the Brookings-Harbor vicinity has increased more than 300 per cent, and even with the auxiliary units, barely enough current was generated to meet demands.

Under present conditions, with the main engine down, it must be asked that people of this area cut down on electric consumption to a possible minimum, especially during the hours when peaks loads tax the plant at full strength. This is especially true in the evening, after five.

With your co-operation, no real inconvenience should be experienced until the plant has again been resored to normal.
