Favorite Recipe

Mrs. Howard T. James, of Harbor, submits her favorite recipe:
CHOCOLATE SUNDAE PIE
 1½ cups milk
 ¼ teaspoon nutmeg.
 1 tablespoon gelatine
 3 tablespoons cold water.
 ½ cup sugar
 ¼ teaspoon salt
 3 eggs
 1½ teaspoons vanilla.

Heat the milk and nutmeg in double boiler. Soak the gelatine in the cold water. Beat egg yolks with ¼ cup sugar and the salt until thick and creamy. Pour hot milk over egg yolks and cool until thick. Remove from fire and add gelatine. Cool in refrigerator tray until it begins to congeal. Beat egg whites until frothy. Add ¼ cup sugar and beat until stiff. Pour in baked pie shell and chill. Grate semi-sweet chocolate over top, when ready to serve.
