Fish Bill Passage Urged By State

The purpose of Fish Bill, ballot measure No. 312, is to save Oregon Steelhead and Salmon (SOS) and while trying to save them, to regulate fishing in coastal streams so as to preserve and protect fish life for future generations.

Oregon once enjoyed great salmon and steelhead runs in almost every coastal stream, in addition to those of the Columbia river. People of clubs interested in fish-life have long been con-

scious of an ever-decreasing supply of these fish. Effort has been made in many sessions of legislature to curb the take of these fish, but due to strong opposition presented by certain commercial fishermen and packers, nothing was ever gained.

At last session of legislature, irrefutable facts were presented—by Oregon Fish and Game Commission—which resulted in HB 53, and an overwhelming vote in the senate. However the opposition invoked the referendum, to be put up to vote, Nov. 5.
