"Never have I seen such de- tion, such utter misery and nutrition as I saw in west- Germany. The people gged their feet along the ds and pavements. Many re without shoes, many h their feet wrapped up pper. They shuffled along h their eyes glued to the und, too weary to raise ir heads. But worse than was the picture of the dren. I have not seen many dren playing in Germany. ny of them' appeared to

have revolting skin diseases. Their legs, arms and necks are covered with a rash. In some cases this rash has broken out on their faces in sores.

"I have personally seen individuals whose tongues and lips were swollen and parched, whose eyes were sunken in their sockets, and whose bodies were such shrunken skeletons.

"In several cities of Germany I saw how the starving went out to eat weeds and gather grass, for they had not enough food to eat; tiny, shrunken children, three and four years old, so gaunt, and gray that they seemed like little old men and women.

"On my last visit to Hamburg a representative of the Public Health Department took me out to visit some of the homes of the people. They had gathered various things from the garbage cans and dumps and were trying to fry their food in candle wax. In other homes we saw how they were using varnish to cook their food."

People of Brookings and Harbor, let us not fail in this hour of human distress. Bring in abundance your offerings of money and clothing to the various organizations which are operating for this purpose, in this territory. Let us make it a happier Christmas for some of these misery-stricken people who must die unless relief comes soon.

Re-Count Asked Sheriff Election

CRESCENT CITY—A request for a re-count of the ballots in the Nov. 5, election which gave Chas. Glover a lead of 23 votes victor over his opponent, Deputy Sheriff Frank J. Blackerby, was filed with the County Clerk, Emma Cooper, Dec. 5. The petition, which was signed by supporters of Blackerby, state that there were several violations at the polls.

Several ballots were discarded due to the signing of pen and pencil which were supposed to be counted, but were rejected, throughout the different polls in the county.
