2. Aid in organization work, those projects which are of civic nature, but come nearer the social side, such as schools, civic functions as festivals, etc.

3. By its national hook-up, a service club has advantages no chamber of commerce could hope for, and by having a service club the chamber could benefit much through this club aid.

Decision as to whether it is Rotary, Lions, or Kiwanis depends up on the people founding a local chapter. However, it is my sincere hope that such a service club is founded here.

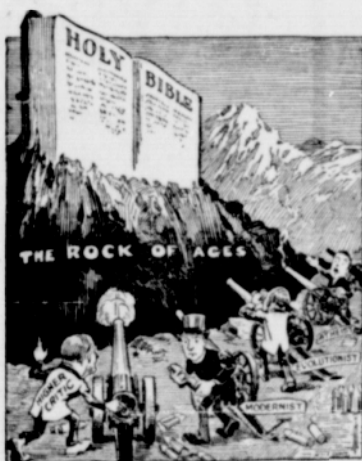
