It was thrilling to me, Monday, to watch the youngsters walking up the hill toward school. I do not believe there was one single lad who wasn't really glad that school had begun. Later these same children were downtown, flocking into stores to buy school needs.

The sad part of this whole controversy was the fact that personalities entered into the discussion, and that the bitterness carried the fight into papers of nearby towns. People of those areas had a ringside seat to a fight which gave them plenty of laughs.

Congratulations are due Cliff Brimm, whose mill went into continuous production, Monday. This mill, together with Brookings Lumber Co., and Swans Mill, once it is rebuilt, will mean that again this area will be identified among the lumbering centers of the state.

With lumber as much in demand as it is, and with future as bright as seems at present, this area still can look with confidence to continuous expansion. This factor will bring, indirectly, a confidence among flower-growers, as well as lily growers. Reports from California claim

that 160,000 a month are migrating into Southern California. Unable to either obtain employment or business opportunity, many of these people have come to this area in the past few months. While this has not made any particular difference in the local picture, it still points to what may be expected in the months to come.

Have you given any thought about the faculty of the Brookings schools? Without any doubt it cannot be matched anywhere for ability. If you doubt this statement, kindly keep your attention focussed on achievements throughout the year.
