## I WRITE

As I See It

In the Scriptures nations are frequently designated by the name of their ancestral founder and it can usually be followed throughout the entire Bible. This is particularly true when such nations come under the scrutiny of the searching eye of prophecy.

If you turn to map one in your Bible Atlas, you will find that the nations adjacent to and north of the Black Sea are named for the early decedents of Noah, who, after the destruction of the Tower of Babel, led their tribes northward and grew into nations. Through the centuries these small nations have largely drifted, or been driven into subjection to a centralized government, which has always been some vicious form of totalitarian overlordship.

Keeping your Bible map before you if you look at your modern map you will read the name Russia, where on your Bible map you read such names as gomer, Magog, Meshach, Tubal, Torgarmah, for whom the small nations now in subjection to the big nations were named.

The thirty-eighth and thirty-ninth chapters of Ezekiel contain a prophetic outline of what the ruler of the nations designated will attempt to do in the latter years. Today our attention is chiefly directed to the thirty-eighth chapter. For sake of brevity we review in part this chapter. We urge you to read it for yourself in connection with this outline.

The second verse introduces the ruler or leader of the coun-

try under consideration. His name is Gog, and he is called the chief prince of all the others. He has many little nations under his power, and the prophet states flatly the Lord is against him and that he is heading into a lot of trouble. In the latter days he is to move toward the land of Palestine, the former home of Israel, which has laid waste for many centuries. He shall ascend and move as a cloud to cover the land. He shall also direct a vast army of expert, well armed horsemen, mounted upon well trained horses. (Russia is the only great power today that employs entire divisions of cavalry in its war operations.)

At the time when this chief prince, Gog, is making preparations to move toward the Dardenelles, Palestine and the Red Sea, "he shall think an evil thought." The margin states, "he shall conceive a mischievous purpose." This purpose is to move upon the lands for which he has so long plotted and planned, and as he marches, to murder, plunder, rape and devastate. Again the prophet declares that this shall take place in the latter days when Gog shall come out of the north parts with his clouds of air equipment and his armies of horses and horsemen. And again the prophet cries that it shall happen in the latter days.

When the day arrives that Gog and all his bands shall decide to march into the coveted land, the prophet writes; "And it shall come to pass at the same time, when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, thus saith the Lord God, that my fury shall come up in my face . . . And I will call for the sword against

him throughout all my mountains, saith the Lord God: every man's sword shall be against his brother. And I will plead against him (Gog) with pestilence and with blood; and I will rain upon his bands, and upon him, an overglowing rain, and great hailstones, fire and brimstones. Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the Lord."—Ezekiel 38: 18, 21-23.

Russia fulfills all the specifications. As events develope, and they will develope rapidly, all those who are students of prophecy will see with constantly clearing vision, in the rapidly unfolding events, the accurate and complete fulfillment of these prophecies concerning Russia. Other great prophecies are taking shape and coming more and more into the open arena of world affairs. At this present moment Russia holds the most conspicuous position in the great Drama of the Ages.
