#### CREAMERY PURCHASED BY SMITH RIVER GROUP

The Del Norte Cooperative Creamery Organizational Committee stated today that negotiations for the purchase of the Golden State plant at Smith River were rapidly approaching a stage of completion. The following persons were appointed to the organizational committee at a countrywide meeting of the dairy producers with instructions to negotiate the purchase of the Golden State plant, formulate plans and complete the details necessary to establish the co-operative as a functioning unit: Henry Westbrook, Chairman, Lester Ulrich, Nis Jepsen, Robert Maris, Clarence Westbrook, Oliver Bailey, Rich McNamara. Mr. Francis Kerner, Attorney-at Law, from San Francisco,

specializing in the legal aspects of tax exempt producers' cooperatives has been engaged by the committee to draw up and file the Articles of Incorporation. Mr. Kerner visited the county during the week and met with the committee. The Articles of Incorporation have been signed and filed with the Secretary of State and it is expected will be approved by the end of this week when the committee will call a final county wide meeting of the producers.

In the meantime arrangements have been made with Golden State to continue the present operation of the plant for the cooperative group from October 1 to 10 by which time it is expected all arrangements will be completed for the cooperative producers to take over the management and operation of the plant.

At a recent committee meeting Mr. Ulrich was appointed Treasurer pro tem of the Cooperative group.

#### FORT DICK WOMAN DIES OF HEART ATTACK

The body of Mrs. Helen Price, who apparently died of a heart attack, was discovered in the yard of her home in the Lake Earl area last Thursday by neighbors.

Her death occurred sometime

during the preceding evening according to a coroner's report.

The deceased woman who was in her early forties, had been subject to heart attacks since she was fourteen years of age. Newcomers to this area, Mrs. Price and her husband, J. G. Price had been in the bulb business.

At the present time Mr. Price is in the Marine hospital at Mare Island reportedly in a serious condition.

Two brothers, Leo Houser of Fillmore, California and Harold Houser of Santa Barbara survive.
