Beans, Peas Good To Aid In Meatless Day Menus

Dry beans and peas are good foods for occasional meatless days, says Aldene N. Roberts, Home Demonstration Agent. Beans are not complete protein foods but make a good substitute for meat when a glass of milk is added. The vitamin B family is well represented in most types of dry beans and they are also very valuable for iron. Excessive use of dried beans sometimes causes digestive disturbances.

The pressure saucepan is a time saver in preparing beans but should not be filled more than 1/2 full of beans and no more than two-thirds full of liquor to prevent closing of the steam vent by expansion. Beans should be soaked several hours before cooking in the saucepan and cooked in the same water. The use of soda decreases the vitamin content.

Dried peas make a delicious soup when seasoned with onion and tomato, especially when they are cooked with a soup bone. They can also be used in cutlets and loaves. Dried beans can be used in chowders, soups, loaves, casseroles and goulash. They can be baked, boiled and made into balls and fried. Recipes for these methods are given in circular HE 1751 "Recipes for Meal Saving", which is available free of charge from your county extension office in Gold Beach. This circular also contains suggest-

tions for the use of lentils, nuts and cheese.

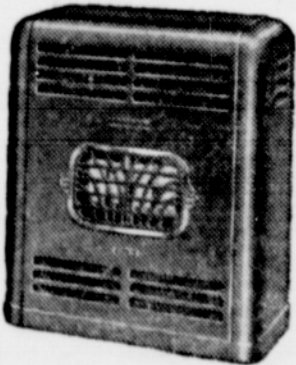

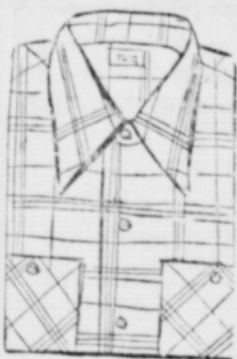
