Fertilizer Use Best Made In Autumn

Now that the season of autumn is almost here, it's a good idea for farmers to give more thought to enriching their soils. Arthur S. King, extension soils specialist at Oregon State College gives a few tips on fall use of fertilizers.

He notes that more fertilizers are available for use this fall than for several years. Even so farmers may not always be able to buy what they want when they want it. There's a good deal of ammonium nitrate available now, but by next spring there may be a shortage, King warns.

King says that applying nitrogen fertilizer in the fall is pretty well established for orchards with permanent cover crops, and as part of the complete fertilizer for berry crops and on perennial grasses for seed. He predicts that its use will increase

on improved grass pastures, on fall seeded grain, on fields where straw is being plowed under as fertilizer, and on annual cover crops.

Here in Oregon, ammonium sulfate, urea and cyanamid are generally preferred for fall use because there is little danger of a loss of nitrogen from leaching, King says. If ammonium

nitrate is used, there won't be much leaching application is made early is to give a week or ten days of good growing weather before rains come.
