## Langlois Cows Are Rated Among Best

COLUMBUS, Ohio—Two registered Jersey cows, owned by Ralph E. Cope Jr., Langlois, have completed production records of merit, as announced by American Jersey Cattle Club, whose officers are here. Poppy Eagle Noble Baby 1395095, completed a production record of 9993 lbs. milk and 688 lbs butterfat, qualifying her for the Gold and Silver medal awards of the club. Noble Baby's record was made on a 305-day test at the age of three years. In compiling this record she produced more than three times as much butterfat as the average dairy cow in the United States.

Eagle Boy Myrtle of I. N. 1404741, completed a production record of 14566 pounds of milk and 841 pounds of butterfat on 305-day test at the age of six year which qualified her for the medal of merit award of the American Jersey cattle club. Her

record was more than four times as much butterfat production as the average dairy cow in the United States.

All tests were verified by both Oregon State College and American Jersey Cattle Club. Both Jerseys have been officially classified for type by the Cattle Club with the high rating of Very Good.
