Curry Co. Council Is Re-Organized

Scouters, representing Port Orford, Gold Beach and Brookings, met at the courthouse, Monday evening for re-organization of the Curry County Council, Boy Scouts of America. Officers named were:

Chairman—R. G. Sabin, Gold Beach.

Vice - Chairman — Mike Page, Brookings.

Secretary—Mr. Thomas, Port Orford.

A member at large was elected from each community. A. P. Hendricks is the local representative.

Problems of each area were brought out in lengthy discussion especially by Gold Beach, on obtaining an active troop, which was attractive to the boys of that community. The veterans of Gold Beach have agreed to sponsor the troop, and also have set up a fund for purchasing uniforms for boys financially unable to furnish these at the beginning of scout training.

Port Orford reported phenomenal progress in the past few weeks, with both cubs and scouts making big strides. A sea scout ship is being planned for that place also, making the second for the county. Port Orford plans an inspection of the local ship

to help them in deciding what type of boat they will seek.

A school for scouts will be held in Brookings, beginning on March 13, when a den mothers school will be held in the afternoon. The next day, Sunday, beginning at 1:30 p.m., all scouts of the county will hold a school of instruction with Dave Putnam in charge. At this time all scouting management problems will be discussed at length. A sea scout instruction will also be held during this week-end.

Bruins Will Enter Dist. Tourney, Fri.

Bruins, champions of Curry county, will enter the Coquille tournament, Friday evening, to decide the representative to be sent to the state tourney at Arlington, early next month, when the B schools of Oregon will decide the state title.

Other teams entering this tourney will be: Drain and Elkton, representing Douglas county; and either Bandon or Powers from Coos county. The playoff for Coos county will be held sometime this week.

According to Arthur Guthrie, the competition in this tourney will be far tougher than anything the Bruins have faced this season. Drain, reported to be the "team to beat", has run rough-

shod over all opposition all year. The same is said about Bandon, which made "monkeys" of several Curry county teams earlier this season.

Guthrie hopes to be able, on the drawing, to have the second game of the evening, and while wishing, to be able to draw Elkton. Guthrie is sitting on a seat loaded with thumb tacks, he assured the Pilot.
