The movement to form a union high school district here, embracing Districts 17, Upper Chetco and Carpenterville, seems to be gaining momentum, if talk may be taken for any worth. People realize that only under such plan will there be a creditable high school in this area, one which will meet approval of the state department of education inspectors.

In a union high school district the per-student cost is divided more equally and in the conduct of the high school, the per-student cost is often lowered in comparison of district high schools. The school comes nearer meeting the requirements, too.

Formation of a union high school district separates the grade from the high school, thus making it easier for the individual districts to conduct schools under a single budget. There is no arguments concerning whether or not the grade school receives more money than it should in relation to the high school.

Union high schools over Oregon seem to have a good rating with the state department, and with all colleges. This seems to come from the fact that most union high schools have more courses to offer students, thus better preparing them for college entrance.

Most union high schools that I know of in Oregon offer such things as home economics, Smith-Hughes agriculture, manual training (or some shop practice course) which is attractive to so many youngsters. I know what Smith-Hughes courses do for schools for I have seen many boys and girls, through their various projects carried on throughout high school, earn money enough to finance a four-year college course.

The government of a union high school rests equally on all districts making up the high school district. This will bring about a "school consciousness"

and better feelings about education of students.

If a union high school district is realized here this spring and followed by a building program, the local schools may become equal to any in the state, and the graduates will enter, on equal footing, college with graduates from any school in the state. That much cannot be said at this moment.
