

OREGON SALUTE SCHEDULED AUG. 30 "SOUND OFF" RADIO PROGRAM

Oregon-born Writer Will Furnish Program Material For Broadcast Over ABC Network

Oregon is the thirteenth state to be honored in the current "Salute to the States," feature of "Sound Off" with Mark Warnow. The new march, written by Choral Director Jeff Alexander and Radio Writer Marve Fisher, will be presented for the first time during the broadcast Monday, Aug. 30, at 8:00 p. m. Eastern Standard Time, and 8:00 p. m. Pacific Standard Time, over the West Coast American Broadcasting Network.
