erly comes around, may bid. This is far lighter than the former severe penalties, by which the offender as well as his partner might be barred and an opponent could call a lead.

INSUFFICIENT BID. The insufficient bid is a frequent offense. An opponent bids two hearts, and you bid two diamonds—either a slip of the tongue or because you thought he bid one heart. Usually no real damage has been done. The law-makers, appreciating this, have made a brand-new—and extremely liberal—law for the insufficient bid.

The New Law gives the offender three choices. First: if an insufficient bid is corrected with the lowest possible bid of the same denomination, there is no penalty. (Formerly the offenders partner was barred for one round of bidding).

Second: you may make any other bid (For instance, if you made that insufficient bid of two diamonds, and you don't want to bid three diamonds, you can change to three no trump or anything else). But if you do this, your partner is barred from further bidding.

Co. Service Officers Reports To You:

The increase for dependents in service-connected cases; this applies to veterans of the Spanish-American war, as well as to World War 1 and 2, if compensation is being paid because of disabilities (60% or more) due to war service.

Increases are also allowed for peace-time compensation cases under some circumstances.

If disabled veteran's rating is total (100%) the amounts shown below will be added to his regular compensation check. If his rating is 60%, 70% 80% or 80%, he would receive a proportionate amount: (first figure for war-time service, second for peace-time):

Veteran with wife and no chil-

dren, \$21.00; \$16.80;

Veteran, wife and one child, \$35.00; \$28.00;

Veteran, wife and two children, \$45.00; \$36.40.

Veteran, wife and three or more children, \$56.00; \$44.80;

Veteran, no wife, two children, \$24.50; \$19.60;

Veteran, no wife, three or more children, \$35.00; \$28.00;

Veteran, mother or father, either or both dependent upon his support, then in addition to the above amounts, \$17.50; \$14.00 for each parent.

If the veteran does not have documentary proof of all dependents in his case file the Veterans Administration he should get all these in at once. No allowance will be made if evidence is not in file.

No new applications will be required. Payment of the amount now due will be automatic. Veterans will not be permitted to receive dependency allowances from more than one source at

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a time.

That is, public law 346 or public law 16, subsistence allowance, only one benefit may be paid but the veteran may choose to receive which ever dependency allowance rate will bring him the larger amount of compensation.
