

New Laws Of Contract Bridge Playing

"I'm down one," when he actually has made his contract, the tricks nevertheless speak for themselves; no bridge lawyer can prevent it.

IMPROPER REMARKS AND GESTURES. There is one law (an improvement—there used to be six), which works like this: If a player's remark or unmistakable gesture gives improper information during the auction, his side is barred from bidding. In addition, if an opponent plays the hand, he may, "require or forbid the opening lead of a specified suit." For the same offense during the play, the offender's partner may be prevented from following the illegal suggestion. On any trick after the offense (but only one trick), an opponent may require a played card to be withdrawn if such play follows the suggestion.

"Talking across the table" is bad manners and frequently conveys a great deal of information. When it does, it should be penalized. But penalties of this kind are difficult to enforce without risking wounded feelings, so let us hope you can forget about this law and never have occasion to use it.

In most respects, however, the laws of contract bridge help you to play the game, and they always should be uniformly followed.
