Coos Bay, Sept. 30, 1948
Editor, Pilot, Brookings:

This is to advise you that we have not completed the installation of the equipment contemplated for some time at our Crescent City office. To relieve the long distance situation we installed a "C" carrier system and another position of switchboard which means that we can more efficiently handle the toll calls offered. We have also installed an "F" carrier system between Crescent City and Coos Bay to relieve the congestion north of Crescent City. The "C" carrier system was for the purpose of providing two additional talking facilities between Crescent City and Eureka, which has increased the number of circuits 100% to Eureka. The additional switchboard position will not only help the long distance situation but will also help by speeding up the local service. The total cost of the three items listed are in the neighborhood of \$25,000. I am sure the people of this area will notice quite an improvement in the service due to these additions in our system.

At present the additional facilities north and south of Crescent City will help relieve the long distance congestion at the Brookings office. It will help even more after the dial system has been installed because at this time we will install additional long distance circuits between Brookings and Crescent City. — West Coast Telephone Co., by Geo. N. McBride, district manager.
