Since the Huskies were toppled by the Cougars of Washington State, it looks like the bubble has burst wide open, and the California Bears are alone in choice of Rose Bowl competition.

U. of O. may go through this season undefeated in conference play, but her chances of doing so have lessened by each succeeding game as the season has progressed. Her victory over the Stanford Indians was less impressive than the 14-7 Washington State win over Sanford.

It seems that coaches who just even believe they have a championship team become targets of every team in the conference, especially so with such little colleges as Idaho and Washington State, whose chief sport has become tipping over the giants.
