

### HOSPITAL MESSAGE SEEMS CERTAINLY NOW

#### Improvement Seems To Gaining Momentum Election Nears

Reports coming to the Pilot conclusively that the County Hospital seems to be certain. These reports, George Mateer told the Pilot, seemed to be accurate also "gaining momentum election nears."

One-third by population, and one-third by year tax levy, the last year is a federal grant of \$100,000.
