#### Christmas Delivery Demands Prompt Action Locally

During war years when so many youth were overseas with armed forces, few people had thought to do their overseas mailing early to insure delivery before Christmas.

National troops wish to receive Christmas just as much as the years ago. Mrs. Goldie reminds local post office that mailing should be done promptly, not later than the week-end, to insure de-

Packages should be wrapped securely, amply tied to prevent damage.

Concerning sending of Christmas cards, Mrs. Smith urges all patrons to send them first class because they will be forwarded in case of the receivers' moving.

"Packages should be addressed on one side only," Mrs. Smith points out, "and the senders are asked not to use 'locker paper' for the wrappings. Outgoing mail should be in the post office before 9 a. m. Office hours are from 7:45 a. m. to 5:30 p. m. With anticipation of a heavy Christmas mail, it will aid the distribution if patrons co-operate in every possible way. No mail will be delivered at the general delivery window after 5:30 p. m."

Probably we will spend the next four years inventing explanations and reasons for our political upheaval that changed the current of national thought overnight. This stupendous experience serves, and how well it does for us to believe, to illustrate how dizzy and dangerous are these times and how uncertain the course of human events.

It is the nature of man to expend much time and effort in attempts to deify and glorify himself. Man craves power, wealth, influence, luxury, indulgence, worldly wisdom and ease.
