

## I WRITE as I See It!

Is man measuring up to, and winning, in his conflict for life and place on earth? A lot of people are deeply concerned about this very matter. The forces arrayed against man's permanent security in pursuit of life, liberty and happiness appear greater, at times, than man is able to cope with.

Take the conditions of which we wrote last week. The polluted atmosphere, the vanishing water supply and depleted soil fertility. These are not minor, widely scattered conditions of rare occurrence. They are with us morning, noon and night, and they encompass the entire world. Added to this, consider the polluted state of the water supply.

This is really a hair-raising menace. Consideration of it understanding is almost enough to make a well-person sick. I cannot remember when I had a drink of water in California that did not taste like an apothecaries shop.

When we read the frequent signs, "Bathing forbidden, polluted water" it causes us to pause and ponder in our meditations.

In many sections of the United States all important streams and rivers are filled with poison and utterly unfit for domestic use until treated with powerful chemicals. This is so common that exceptions are rare. In many areas of salt water, sea life is filled with poison and unfit for food. Now I am leaving this with what has been said. I earnestly ask you to carefully read the following Scripture which is a vivid portrayal of conditions that must be very near in their healthy march upon us.

And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your way and pour out the vials of wrath of God upon the earth. And the first went and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a foison and grievous sore upon the men

which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image. And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea.

And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of water; and they became blood; And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou are righteous, O Lord, which art, and was, and shall be, because thou hast judged thus. And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are thy judgments. And the fourth angel poured his vial upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire. And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: And they repented not to give him the glory.
