

Pelicans Won First Round With 15-12 Defeat Of Merlin, In 13 Frames, Sun.

It took a lot of baseball, Sunday, for Brookings Pelicans to down Merlin, (four hours of it) and 13 innings under intense heat, 15 to 12 to cop the first round leadership. So intense was the heat that Pelican pitchers were a dime a dozen, but for Westbrook couldn't Pelican pitchers were a dime a dozen, for Hank Westbrook couldn't so Swearingen had to be the hope for Brookings.

Cave Junction, tied until Sunday, with Brookings for league lead, suffered a humiliating defeat at the hand of Glendale, 17 to 6, thus giving the sun-burned Pelicans the league lead.

Brookings started out with five runs in the first and lone tallies in the second and third, supposedly headed for another easy win. Merlin, however, countered with a single run in the first and two

in the second, all un-earned.

Hank Westbrook, new Pel pitcher, was extremely wild in the Merlin half of the third and was relieved after five runs scored with none out. Dick Salvage put out the fire with an additional run that inning and then went on to pitch shout-out ball until the eighth when the heat got the best of him and he had to retire, bringing in Manager Babe Swearingen.

Bob Westbrook drove in two runs with a single in the top of the ninth to put the Pels ahead, 10 to 9, but Merlin had other ideas, and came right back to tie the score on a walk, a passed ball and two infield outs. The 10th and 11th were scoreless. Brookings scored twice in the 12th and again Merlin knotted the count in her half.

To make certain this didn't occur again, the Pels scored three runs in their half of the 13th, and Swearingen retired the Merlin swatters, one-two-three to end the marathon affair.

There will be no more league games until July 10, but Merlin comes to Brookings next Sunday, and Eagle Point is expected here for two games over July 3 and 4, during Lily Festival.

Co. Service Offices Reports To You:

For information of veterans, now residing in Oregon, but who lived and entered military service from other states, the following states have voted and are now paying a state bonus for World War 2 veterans.

Connecticut, Massachusetts, Illinois, Michigan, North and South Dakota, Indiana, Minnesota, Ohio, Iowa, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Louisiana, New York, Vermonts, Alaska and Hawaii.

Requirements necessary for obtaining the bonus in any of the foregoing states vary as to length of residence before entering the service, also amounts to be paid for domestic and foreign service. In most states eligible survivors of veterans who died in service are also within the bonut benefits.

The deadline for applying in several of the states is very short (matter of several weeks), and your county service officer will gladly furnish more detailed information regarding the various

states' requirements, and amount being paid. Also the proper address as to whom, and where to write for applications. Phone 343 or contact this office for information, as well as assistance in obtaining applications.
