Military Discharges

A spot check of the county court houses by the Oregon department of veterans' affairs recently revealed that an alarming number of war veterans have neglected to record their military discharges as a safeguard in the event of loss of their original papers. About one-half of the estimated World War 2 veterans have taken advantage of free recording service provided by law.

"This indicates that veterans generally are neglecting to protect one of their most valuable possessions," William F. Gaarenstroom, director of the state's veteran department. "State law provides that the counties will make this a free service. Every veteran should take advantage of it, because in the event of loss of his original papers because of fire, theft, mutilation or misplacement, he can always obtain a photostatic or certified copy from his county clerk for a small fee." Your county service officer has

seen too many instances where a veteran or his next of kin has suffered costly delays in securing compensation, pensions and other veteran benefits due to the lack of not recording the discharge, and the original papers were lost.

Your county service officer will gladly assist all veterans to have their military discharges recorded, giving proper care against loss while in our hands. Drop a card, or phone 343 for more detailed information.

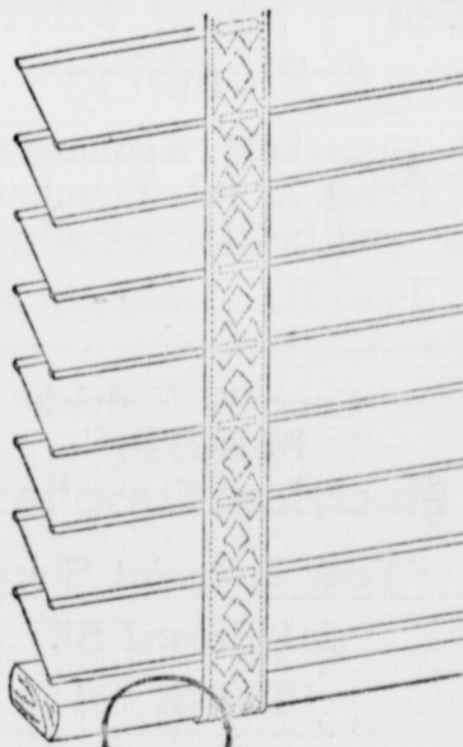
