Everything is being done to make it possible for all residents of the county over 15 years of age to have free miniature chest X-rays. Only a few minutes are necessary for the X-ray, a short period to pay for health protection. This service is free, but it pays off in health dividends, says Mrs. R. L. Erickson, president of Curry county tuberculosis and health association.

## Southwest Oregon Will Get Power By B. P. A. Moneys

EUGENE — Bonneville Power Administration appropriations of \$46,524,000 for the 1949-50 fiscal year, signed last week by President Truman, assure continued progress in constructing transmission facilities to most critical power deficit areas of the Pacific northwest, said Administrator Paul J. Raver. Construction projects include facilities in Oregon, Washington, Northern Idaho and Western Montana.

The major construction facilities affecting service to southwest Oregon are:

Main 230 KV grid: Goldendale-Detroit-Goshen transmission line, including Goshen substation, cash \$3,060,250; contract authority, \$2,183,700.

115 KV transmission facilities: Salem-Albany-Lebanon transmission line, including Lebanon substation, \$672,000 cash; \$396,400 contract authority.

Eugene-Reedsport transmission line, including Reedsport substation, and Eugene-Goshen line No.
