Veterans in training under the G. I. Bill are reminded by the Veterans Administration that if they acquire dependents, or additional dependents, during their school term or training period they should notify the V. A. at once, supplying legal evidence such as certified copies of public records of birth, baptism, or marriage.

Subsistence payments will be

increased as of the date the V. A. receives this legal evidence, not as of the date of dependency.

Your county veterans service officer can obtain certified copies of most public records free of cost when pertaining to any phase of veterans rights or benefits. He also has the various types of forms needed in applying for the different benefits, and will assist in filling of same.
