New Equipment Has Arrived Here For Playground

A "Jungle Jim," a special type of playground equipment for the youngsters of the primary grades of the local school, has been unloaded at the school grounds, to be erected soon. This was a gift from Brookings Rotary Club, a beginning of the club's proposed program for adding equipment to the playground as rapidly as the club can finance the project.

It is the plan of the club to build a couple of tennis courts early next year, on the corner of the athletic field, near the high school building.

With the Azalea Garden Club working on the landscaping of the entire grounds, and with an ambitious program planned as a year's project, the district will have, without cost to the tax-

payers, a school plant of which everyone can be proud.

This Jungle Jim equipment is a series of rings and ladders for climbing, to develop the arms and bodies of the youngsters. These rings, forming a pyramid, are constructed of pipes, which are rust-resisting, and sufficiently large to withstand all the weight of the number of children which can climb on it.

The yearbooks for Smith River Woman's club were delivered last week by the Pilot. These books contain details for an active year's work of those women who sponsor the library at Smith River as one of the projects.
