Rogue River Routed, Monday

With Henry (Big Hank) Westbrook hurling ball like a champion all the way, Rogue River, for the second time, was trampled by the Pelicans, Monday, 22 to 2, a rout far worse than the 12 to 0 whitewashing handed them a week before when Astin applied the brush. While Big Hank allowed seven hits, he kept them a week before when Astin in the second and fourth innings when errors were the contributing factors, did Rogue River do any scoring, or have a chance.

The Pelicans, on the other hand, were downright vicious in their batting attack, gathering in 24 base hits with plenty of extra bases sandwiched in to make the score impressive. Astin, in left field, poled two homers and Matson contributed another in the barrage. Nobody went hitless in the fray.

The first inning started out with Rogue River getting a free pass and a hit to threaten, but a fast fielding play saved Westbrook trouble. The Pelicans were unable to do any better in their half. In the second the Rogues pushed over the first run of the

game, but the Pelicans came back in their half to score two. This was duplicated in the last of the third while Rogue River drew a blank. In the fourth the Rogues scored their last, for Big Hank was master from then on. In their half of the fourth the Pelicans pushed over five on four hits. In the fifth, sixth and seventh, the Pelicans added a brace each inning, until the last of the eighth when it seemed the Rogue River defense fell apart at the seams and permitted the Pelicans to send ten men to the plate to score seven runs on as many hits.

Were To Have Played Tuesday

Before game time the understanding was that Rogue River would play again the Fourth, but after the rough treatment handed out by the Pelicans, the visitors figured enough was sufficient, and said they were going back home, leaving the local vicinity without baseball Tuesday.
