

Bus Travel Feature Of Two "Stories"

Two leading national magazines have come out this month with long feature articles about Greyhound Lines and bus travel. An article in July *American Magazine* is by Don Eddy, titled "T'ma Vacation Bus Rider." An other article, "You Can't Miss America By Bus," by Howell Walker, is the lead story of the July *National Geographic*.

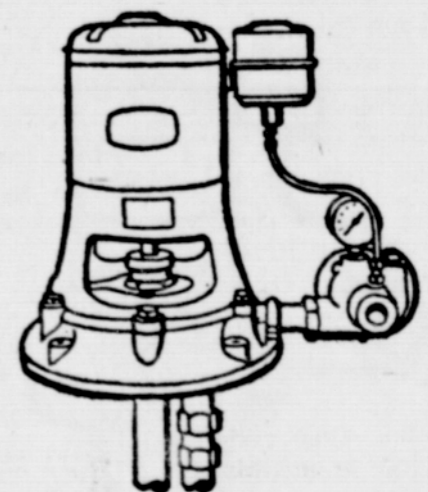
