

### Central Point Eked 4 To 3 Decision In Torrid Game, Sun.

While Central Point managed to maintain her perfect record in Southern Oregon League play, Sunday, she knew that she had been in a baseball game, Sunday, when she was barely able to eke out a 4 to 3 decision over the battling Pelicans. It was over a disputed ground-rule that the Central Point Studs were able to take the lead.

The Pelicans drew first blood in the second when Barrett hit a double down left field line, went to third on an infield out, and scored on Astin's long fly to right.

Westbrook, who started for the Pelicans got by nicely until the third, despite a first inning triple by McDonald, second man up. In the fateful third, the first two men hit doubles, a couple of walks and two more hits produced three runs.

In the fourth, Matson singled, advanced on Barrett's single, and both scored on Jollie's single.

After Astin relieved Westbrook in the third, he put out the fire and then pitched a heroic game until the eighth with Central Point being let down on four hits until the eighth when Central Point hit one to left field which landed in the cars, which, according to usual ground rules was good for two bases. While Hanscam was looking for the ball the runner scored. Umpire Putnam ordered him back to second, to start a "beef" which Matson permitted to pass as a home run. That lapse in interpreting ground rules cost the Pelicans the game and their possible sixth straight win. The box score:
