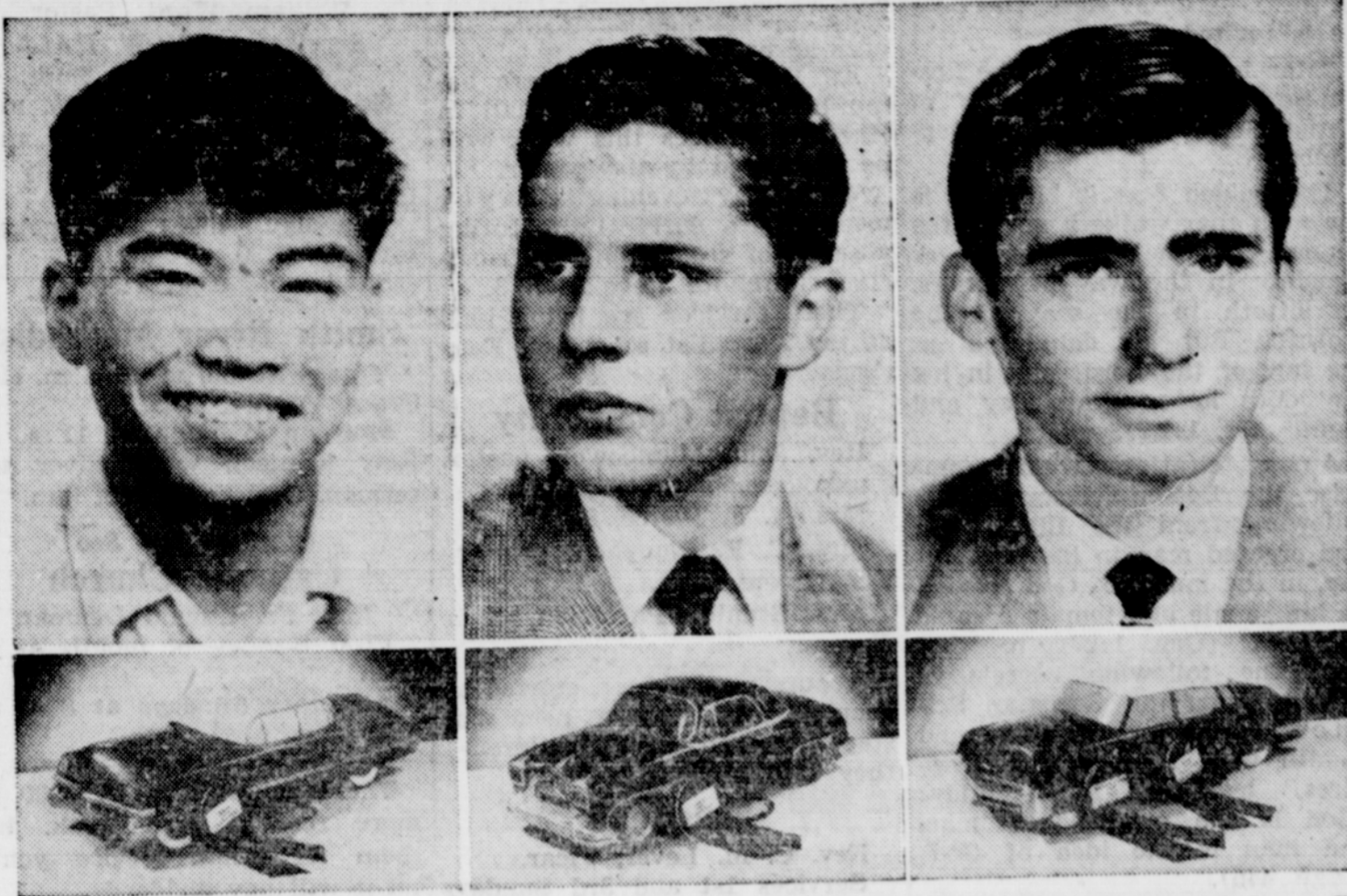


## Oregon Boy Designers Win

In a letter to the Brookings chamber of commerce, the Curry county fair board asked that this community enter floats in the parade at Gold Beach on Sept. 2. The letter:

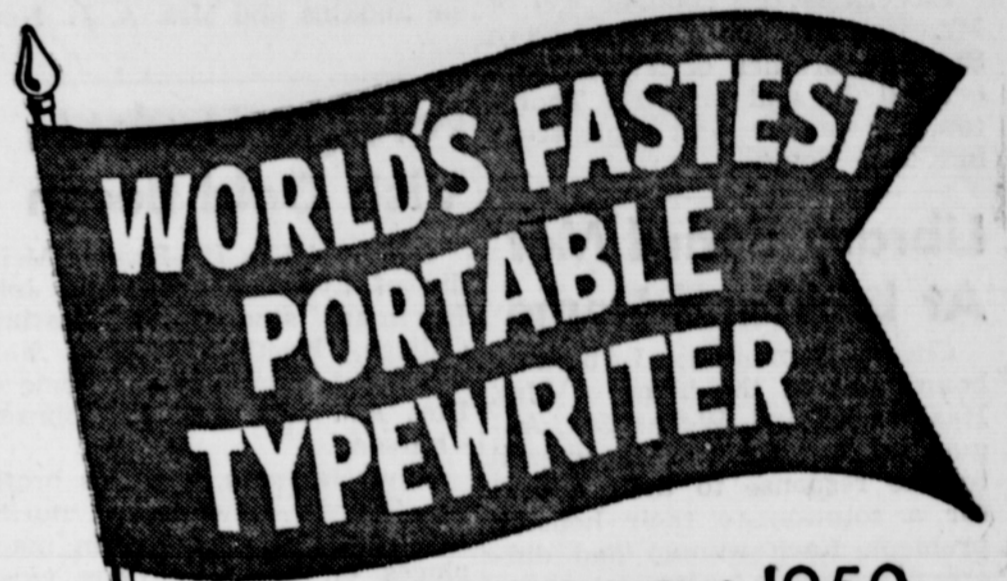

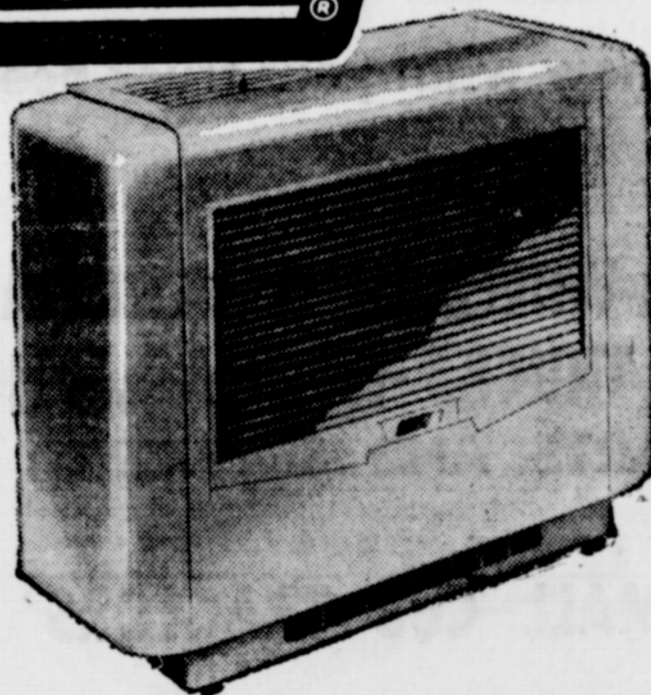
