the I. O. O. F. hall as the VFW group will dedicate their hall on that day.

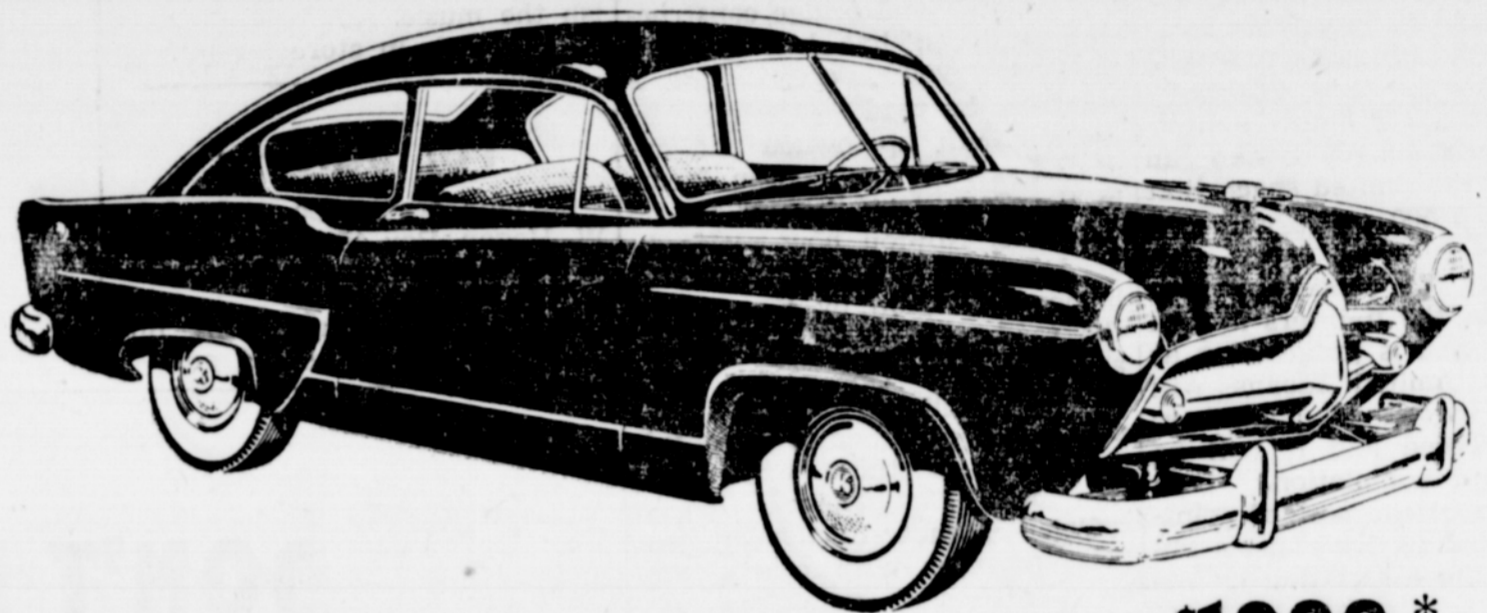
