Beaver State, for both boys and girls, is a plan for training in the functional aspect of citizenship. It is a program of education, sponsored by the American Legion, department of Oregon, to teach the youth of today constructive attitudes toward the American form of government.

Beaver State attempts to show that our scheme of government has not outgrown its usefulness, that all a democracy needs is an intelligent citizenry and a clean, honest and impartial administration responsive to the will of the people.

This program, originated in Illinois in 1934, has been nationally adopted by the Legion and Auxiliary. The 1951 school will be the 15th session for the Beaver State.

Haggerty Attends "K.-F. Meeting"

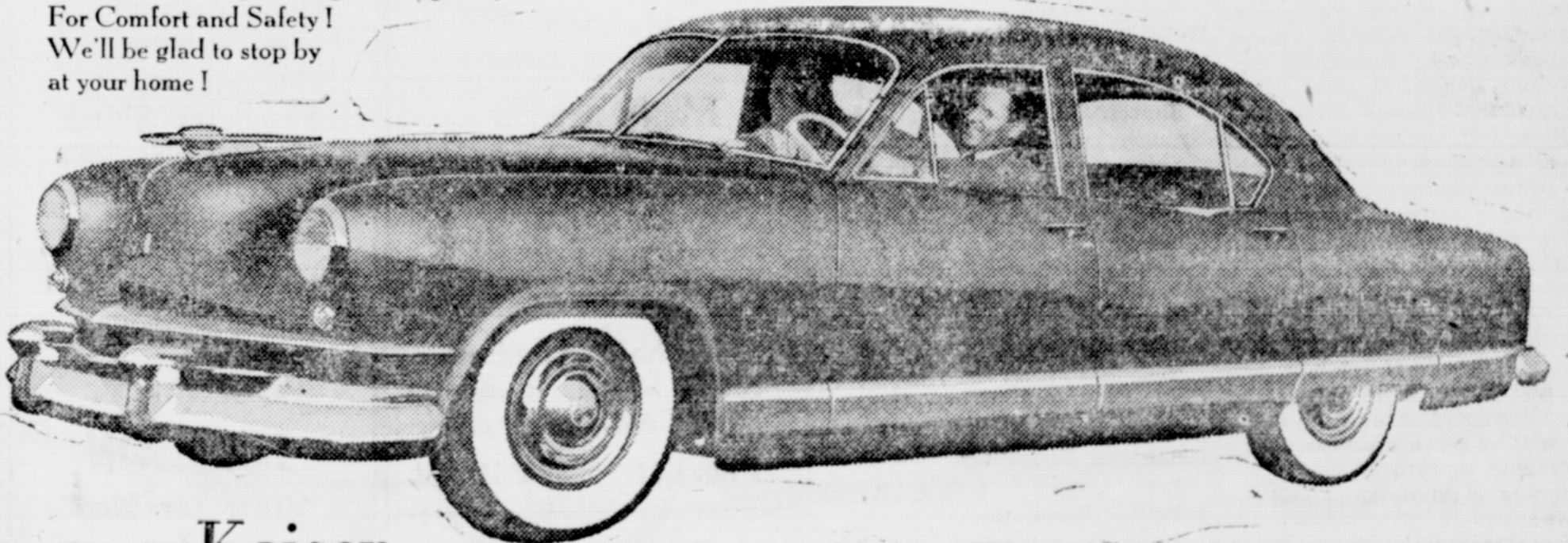
