

Notice of Election

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That on the 10th day of July, 1951, at Brookings, in the Brookings Precinct, Curry County, Oregon, an election will be held at eight o'clock in the morning and will continue until eight o'clock in the afternoon of said day for the purpose of submitting the following proposition to the legal voters residing within the boundaries described in the proposition.

A City to be known as the City of Brookings shall be incorporated within boundaries as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Government Lot Four (4), in Section Thirty-six (36), Township Forty (40) South, Range Fourteen (14) West of Willamette Meridian in Curry County, State of Oregon, this being also the interior 1/4 Section corner of said Section 36; thence following the North boundary line of Harris State Park of the Parks division of the Oregon State Highway Commission south 71 degrees, 0.0 minutes West to its intersection with the mean low water line of the Pacific Ocean; thence following said mean low water line of the Pacific Ocean southerly and easterly to its intersection with the thread of the stream of the Chetco River at the confluence of said river with the Pacific Ocean; thence following said thread of the Stream of the Chetco River northerly to its intersection with the extended North boundary of Government Lot Two (2) of Section Five (5), Township Forty-one (41) South, Range Thirteen (13) West of Willamette Meridian in Curry County, Oregon; thence following said North line of said Lot Two (2) West to the Southeast (SE) corner of Government Lot Three (3), Section Five (5), Township Forty-one (41) South, Range Thirteen (13) West of Willamette Meridian; thence following the East line of said Lot Three (3) and of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section Thirty-two (32), Township Forty (40) South, Range Thirteen (13) West of Willamette Meridian, north to the Northeast (NE) corner of said Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) of said Section Thirty-two (32); thence West following the North line of the South one-half of the Southwest Quarter (S 1/2 SW 1/4) of said Section Thirty-two (32), Township Forty (40) South, Range Thirteen (13) West of the Willamette Meridian, and continuing West, following the North line of the South One-half of the South One-half (S 1/2 S 1/2) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Forty (40) South, Range Thirteen (13) West of the Willamette Meridian, to the West Line of said Section Thirty-one (31) this being the Township Line; thence North on said township line to the Northeast (NE) corner of the Southeast Quarter (NE 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Thirty-Six (36), Township Forty (40) South, Range Fourteen (14) West of Willamette Meridian; thence West following the North Line of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Forty (40) South, Range Fourteen (14) West of Willamette Meridian to the point of beginning—the boundaries hereinabove described and set forth being the exterior boundaries of the city.

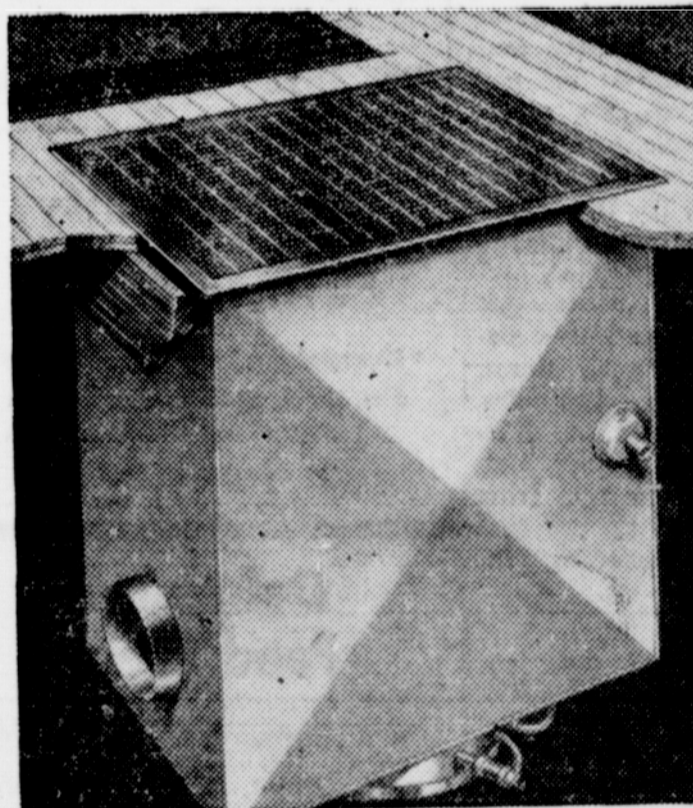

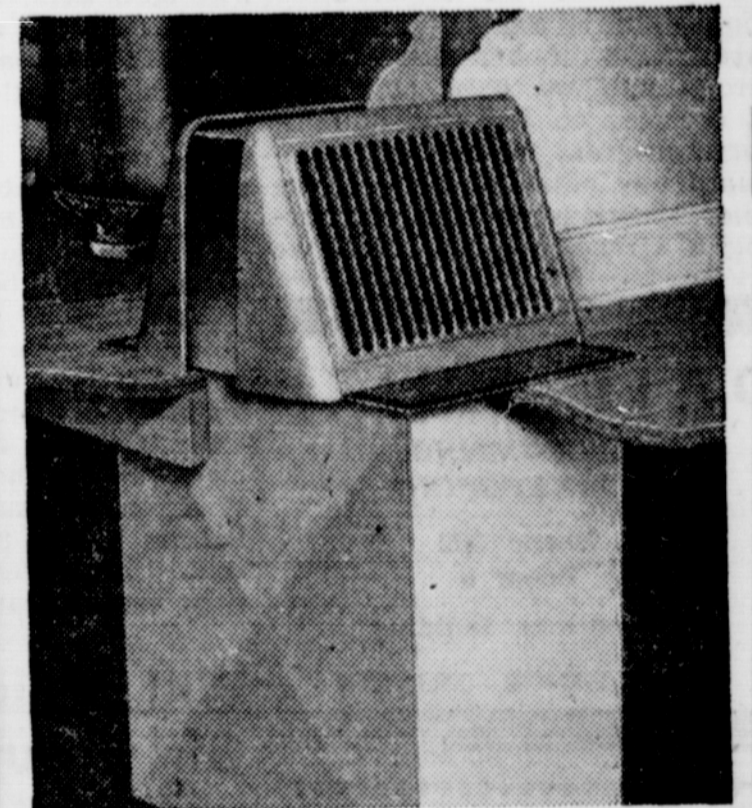
